
Compassion commanded
























Why compassion ministry?

- 2. Because the Spirit often blesses our loving actions with opportunities to share the good news of Christ.






CCC Examples
















The Unexpected Blessings of Compassion Ministry

> The "why" of compassion: Not to get blessings from God Not to get blessings from others But simply because God first loved us



















Closing Thought
